There has been a Parish Church in Heavitree for over a thousand years and **St Michael & All Angels** is the latest Parish Church to stand on the site next to the Millennium Yew from which it is rumoured Heavitree received its name.

The present building dates from 1846, with the tower being erected in 1887 to commemorate Queen Victoria's Golden Jubilee, followed by the installation of a fine ring of eight bells in 1897 for her Diamond Jubilee. Inside there are still traces of the Norman and medieval churches which preceded the current building.

Today the Parish of Heavitree extends from College Avenue to Middlemoor and from Hamlin Gardens to the River Exe. It is served by two churches, the Parish Church, a stone's throw from Fore Street and St Lawrence's in Lower Hill Barton Road together with St Paul's in Burnthouse Lane which is currently being redeveloped.
